WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING TO ORIENTATION:

- ✓ If you have **not** updated your emergency contact info or completed the acknowledgements in your Aeries Parental Portal you must bring your completed and signed emergency sheet with signatures in all the requested areas located on the second page.
- ✓ Completed, signed, parking permit **ONLY if** you are a junior or senior.
- ✓ Completed, signed, off-campus permission card **ONLY if** you are a senior with a 2.0 GPA and a "C" in citizenship at the end of 2nd semester last school year.

Students must be in dress code for orientation and picture taking. Your student ID pictures will be taken at this time. Please refer to the attached dress code information. Students out of dress code will be supplied with a loaner t-shirt for pictures. This picture will also be used for the yearbook.

Textbooks will be checked out from the library during the orientation times. A 2019-2020 Student I.D, card and schedule will be required to pick up textbooks.
